✓ THE SAN DIEGO LEAGUE IN ACTION

- ◆ Conducts several monthly neighborhood Unit meetings where citizens study current issues.
- ◆ Conducts candidate forums, provides speakers on ballot measures and publishes the "Election Extra" which includes an analysis of ballot measures.
- ◆ Conducts public forums with a speaker or panel of experts on current topics.
- ◆ Arranges bus tours of local developments and sites of environmental interest.
- ◆ Presents official League positions at City Council hearings and school board meetings as well as local commissions and boards.

The League of Women Voters takes positions on issues that have been studied by the members and where a consensus has been reached. LWV never supports or opposes candidates or political parties.
